## **Phonics & Spelling:**

*\*This skill is being tested weekly through your child's spelling test*

I can read and spell words using the following patterns:

- ☐ [Short vowels](#): checkup, catnap
- ☐ [Silent E](#) (long vowels): cupcake, racetrack
- ☐ [Initial and final blends](#): stage, glide
- ☐ [Words with -ng](#) (ang, ing, ong, ung): rang, clung
- ☐ [Words with -nk](#) ( ank, ink, onk, unk)
- ☐ [Consonant digraphs](#) (ch, th, tch, wh, sh): sunshine, white
- ☐ [Endings -ed, -ing](#): riding, chased Sounds of "y": (Ex. my, puppy)

## **Reading Literature:**

## **Reading Nonfiction:**

## **Number Sense:**
